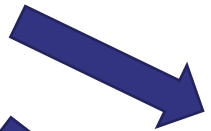

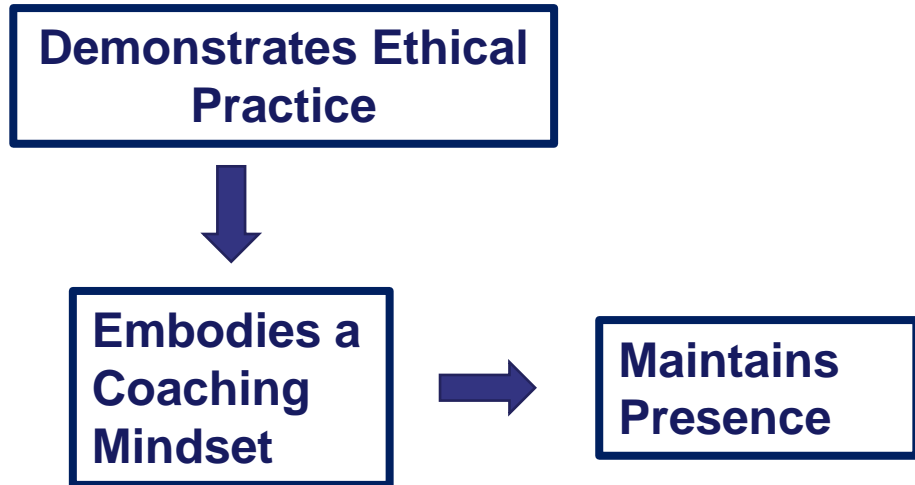
Maintaining the distinction between coaching and other support professions, and in particular the concept of *partnering*, is critical to *embodying a coaching mindset*

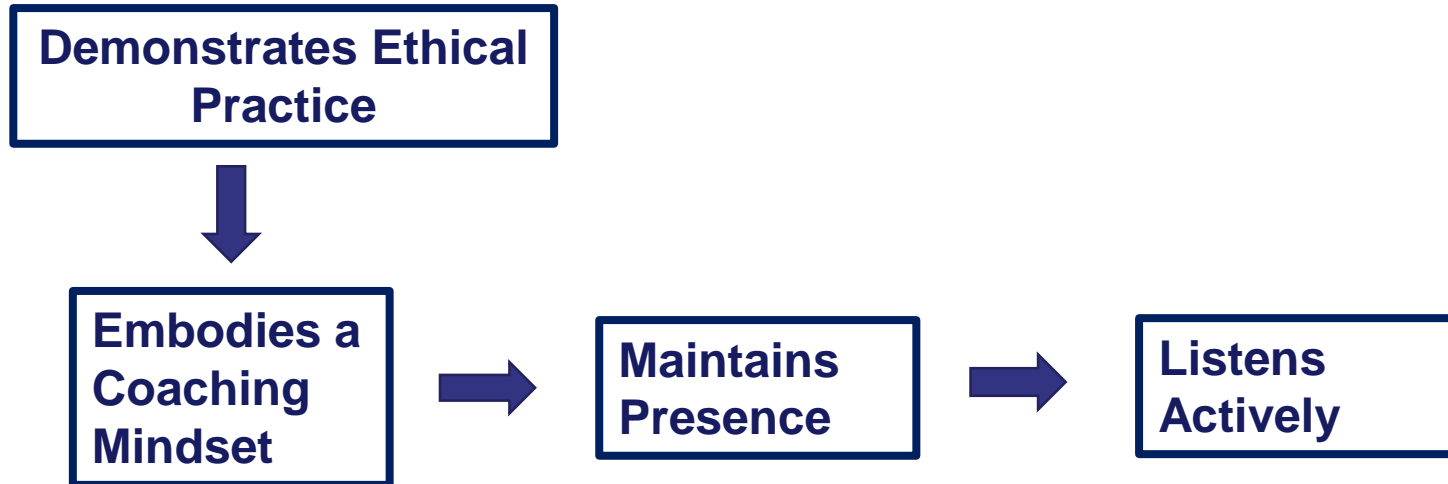


Embodies a Coaching Mindset

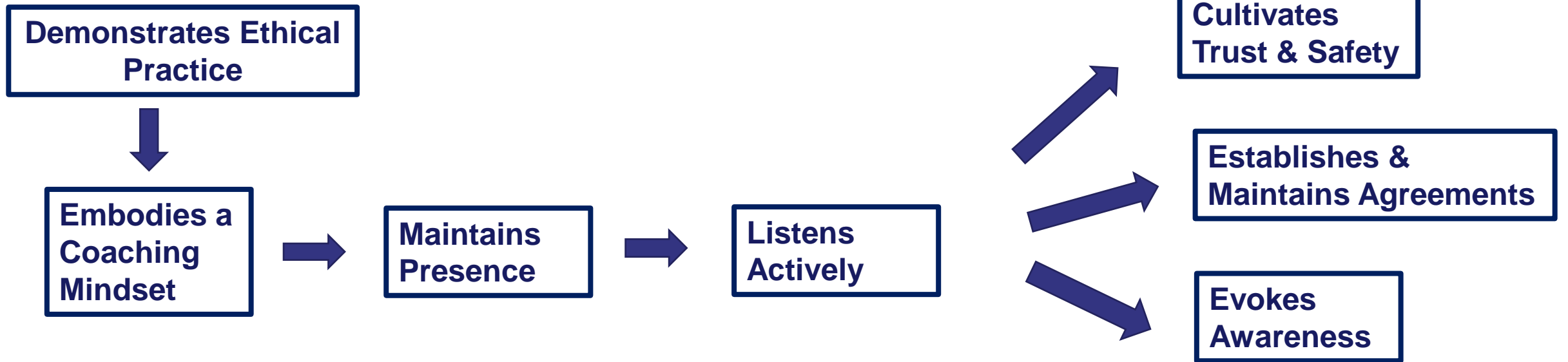
