To be eligible, you must complete at least 200 hours of coaching education and gain 2,500 hours of client-coaching experience. By holding a PCC, you are already on your way to the top level of coaching professionals!

Level 3 Path

Education Provided: Completion of a Level 3 accredited coaching education program.

Additional Requirements: Two recorded coaching sessions and accompanying transcripts for performance evaluation and 2,500 hours of coaching experience

Portfolio Path

Education Provided: 200 hours of coaching education.

Additional Requirements: Separate verification of mentor coaching and two recorded coaching sessions and accompanying transcripts

Experience Requirements

Total Hours Required: 2,500 hours of coaching experience

Clients: Experience must be included with at least 35 clients

Paid Hours: At least 2,250 of the 2,500 hours must be paid

Mentor Coaching Requirements

Total Hours Required: 10 hours of mentor coaching

Timing: Sessions must be spread over at least three months

Format: At least three of the 10 hours must be one-to-one with the mentor coach; the rest can be one-to-one or in a group

Mentor Qualification: The mentor must be an active ICF credential-holder at the MCC level

Duration: Must occur over three months or longer, with at least three one-on-one sessions

Performance Evaluation Requirements

Evaluation Needed: You must pass a performance evaluation

Evaluation Method: ICF assessor reviews two recorded coaching sessions (20-60 minutes) with transcripts

Exam Requirements

Exam Type: Computer-based written exam

Exam Provider: Pearson VUE offers on-site or online proctored options

Exam Content: Measures knowledge of the ICF definition of coaching, Core Competencies, and Code of Ethics

If you apply for a higher-level credential within one year of your current expiration date, you can maintain your current credential status for up to 12 months while your new credential application is being reviewed. This means there is no need for a separate renewal application or fees, allowing you to focus on your upgrade without interruption.

You will then be able to create and complete the MCC credential application.
