The Veteran Journey

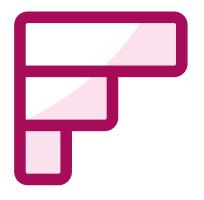
- Enlistment → Service → Transition → Reintegration

Challenges In Transition

- Loss of identity and rank
- Mental health: PTSD, depression, or anxiety
- Navigating civilian systems
- Underemployment & career mismatch

Understanding Veteran Culture

• Language, customs, camaraderie

Mission-oriented mindset

Sensitivity to authority and structure

Culturally Responsive Coaching

- Use clear structure and purpose
- Avoid over-pathologizing behavior
- Honor lived experience
- Learn military terminology respectfully

Coaching Tools for Veteran Clients

- StrengthsFinder
- Values clarification exercises
- SMART goals with accountability
- Journaling and reflection

Scenario:

- Client: Former Army Officer, transitioning to education sector
- Challenges: Career uncertainty, emotional burnout, isolation
- Coaching: Purpose alignment, identity reframe, career planning

Inclusive marketing and service design
